Effective compacts:

- Focus on student learning skills
- Describe how teachers will help students develop those skills using high-quality instruction
- Share strategies parent can use at home
- Explain how teachers and parents will communicate about student progress
- Describe opportunities for parents to volunteer

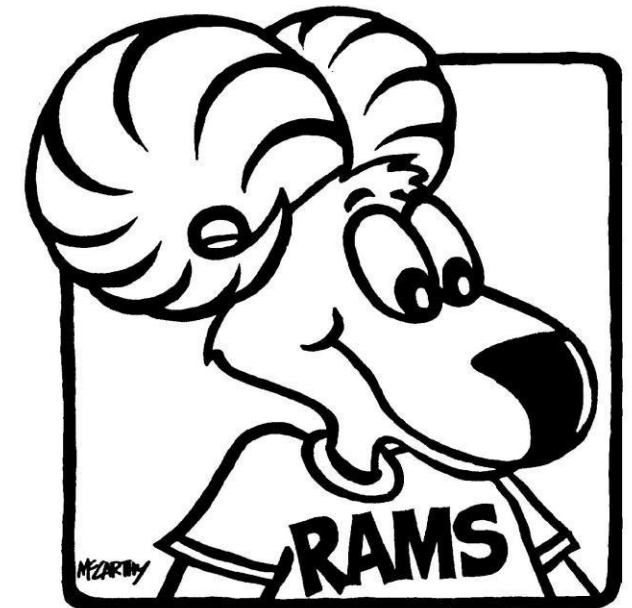

Our Goals for Student Achievement

District Goals

Every campus will improve student performance on the STAAR/EOC assessment in each of the accountability groups as measured by:

- a. Increasing the number of students passing all tests until 95% are accomplishing this measure.
- b. Reducing the number of students failing more than 1 test.

School Goals

All students will make at least a year's growth in their learning of reading, math, science and writing.

Our focus in reading will be to have all students reading on or above grade level by the end of the year.

Our focus in math will be for all students to master understating numeracy and problem solving.

Our focus in writing will involve Empowering Writers and all students writing daily.

Our focus in Science is that all students will be involved in hands on learning to ensure mastery of TEKS.

At School

Avondale Staff will work with students and their families to support student success in all subject areas by:

- Developing a daily reading and comprehension log with students and sending home materials to help parents support their learning.
- Using the “word wall” to incorporate new words and send new words to families each week.
- Designing a parent share day once a week where parents can take turns coming and reading to their child's class.
- Developing goals with students that focus on increasing their skill in reading and comprehension. Send goals to parents along with some practical ideas for supporting their learning goals at home.
